POSTER PRESENTATION RULES







The minimum size of a poster is Ai portrait (594mm wide x 841mm high) and maximum size is Bi portrait (707mm wide x 1000mm high).

Text and graphics should be readable from 2 meters (6 feet).

Authors should bring their own printed poster with them to the conference. We are unable to accept posters in advance by mail or to print posters on site.

You will be timetabled to stand with your poster for 45 minutes during Poster Presentation Time.

Please remove your poster at the end of the day or it may be discarded.





Please hung your poster at least 30 minutes before the start of your session. Each poster has a number in the conference program and must be placed at the board matching its number.

Presenting a poster is less formal than a talk. Your role is to stand by your poster to offer information and answer questions about your research. While some people like to read posters on their own, the majority of people are thrilled to have you "walk them through the poster".

We will provide free-standing poster boards and suitable fixing materials. Tables or other support devices will not be provided and are not allowed. Business cards and small handouts may be attached to the poster board.
